

# Painting Acrylic:

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You will need these supplies by the first day of class.

## **Brushes:**

2 - 3" gesso or sponge brush

**Synthetic: Due to inconsistencies with numbering across brands, measurements are included. Have a variety such as illustrated in the photo on the next page**

## **Recommendation Galaria or White sable**

#2 or #4 round (*2mm to 4 mm wide*)

#4 filbert - *1/8 inch wide*

#8 filbert - *1/4 inch wide*

#12 filbert - *1/2 inch wide*

#12 flat - *1/2 inch wide*

#10 flat - *3/4 to 1 inch wide*

## **Pigments: Liquitex or Golden**

Titanium White (Large Tube)

Cadmium Yellow Light

Cadmium Red Medium

Quinacradone Red – Not Magenta

Alizarin Crimson – Not Magenta

Ultramarine Blue

Phthalocyanine Blue

Phthalo Green

Burnt Sienna

Burnt Umber

White acrylic gesso – 16 oz

**1 small tube of neutral gray acrylic for priming canvas**

## **Medium:**

Golden - Acrylic glazing medium

## **Hardware:**

Painting knife 2- 2 1/2" inch blade (Triangle shape )

Paper palette , or wet palette (Sta-wet pallette with a sponge is good)

Bar of soap: Ivory, Lava

Tupperware or travel soap container.

1 medium sized jar for rinsing out your brushes.

## **Surfaces:**

1 yard of unprimed Medium Grade canvas

**Stretcher Bars: 14" x 16" , 14" x 18"**

**1 sheet BFK paper**
